Travelling by Car:

An easy to find turn-off from the Pacific Highway (Highway One) between Ballina and Byron Bay, sign posted 'Lennox Head'....OR.....

Take the scenic coast road, Angels Beach Drive, from Ballina to Byron Bay that passes through Lennox Head, and offers spectacular views of sweeping surfing beaches, rocky headlands and lush rainforests growing down to the sea.

Travelling by Air:

Regional air carriers fly Sydney to Ballina-Byron Gateway Airport, Ballina.....OR.. International air carriers fly to Brisbane International and the Gold Coast airports.



Travelling by Coach:

Interstate coach Terminals are in Ballina and Byron Bay. Rail Countrylink coaches stop in Lennox Head adjacent to the Resort.

Travelling by Train:

The XPT Rail Service - Sydney to Brisbane stops at Byron Bay.



Airport, Rail and Bus Terminals offer Transfers and all have car hire.

The ocean tempers Lennox Head's sub-tropical climate so it is never blazingly hot and rarely cold enough to demand more than a pullover. Light casual clothing is suitable (warmer clothing may be necessary in winter). Remember to wear a hat and sun block in summer. Average annual rainfall: 1745mm (68")

Temperatures: Summer: 19 to 32°C (66 - 90°F)
Winter: 11 to 26°C (50 - 70°F)
